

Questions for River of Angels

Readers to Ponder:

- 1. If you were to name the main characters in River of Angels, who would they be and why? Reflect on those that speak and those who do not.
- 2. "Everything matters Carlos, even a grain of sand." What does Rosie mean by this? What significance does sand have beyond the obvious?
- 3. Monica carries prejudices within herself, judgments. Who does she judge? How is she similar to Abuelita and Rosie?

How is she different?

- 4. What significance does the cave have in the story? Which world is more real?
- 5. Explore the idea of color, dark and light, black and white, color, passion.
- 6. How are vines used as a metaphor in the story? Think of growth, purpose, negative and positive.
- 7. Rosie is considered a healer as is Abuelita. Who heals or changes in the story and how?
- 8. "Fate is patient". How does relate to secrets and actions of Abuelita, Monica, Carmen, and Carlos?
- 9. Explore the themes of birth---- Pigeons, Rosie, Carmela, and that of Jesus and Carlos.'
- 10. If this were a religious story how would you use the ideas of healer, faith, voodoo, trust and redemption?
