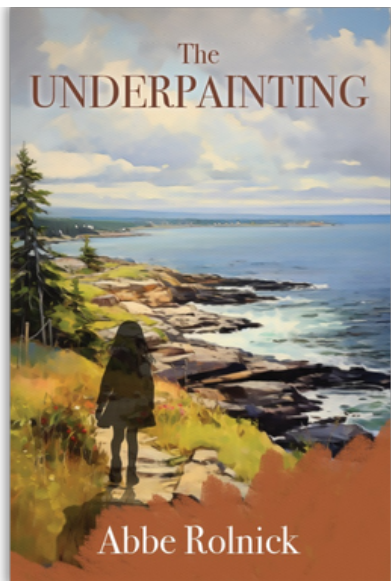


THE UNDERPAINTING
